The State of Maryland to the Sheriff of Prince Georges County, greeting. Whereas a certain Barton Morris alias James Jones stands charged on the affidavit of David Handley taken by the Court of Loudoun County, in the Commonwealth of Virginia, with having committed a felony, in the Commonwealth aforesaid in stealing a horse and saddle the property of the said David Handley, of which affidavit an authenticated copy has been transmitted to me: And whereas it is represented to me that the said Barton Morris alias James Jones hath been arrested and is now confined in the jail of Prince Georges County. And whereas His Excellency Thomas M Randolph Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, hath represented to me that the said Barton Morris alias James Jones, hath fled from the jurisdiction of the Commonwealth of Virginia having jurisdiction of the offence aforesaid to the State of Maryland, and hath demanded of the Executive of this State the delivery of the said Barton Morris alias James Jones as a fugitive from justice; and hath notified to me in due form that he hath appointed Mr David Handley of the County of Loudoun Agent to remove him to the said Commonwealth of Virginia. I have therefore thought proper to order and direct that you deliver the said Barton Morris alias James Jones to the said David Handley to be removed to the said Commonwealth of Virginia provided the said Barton Morris alias James Jones has not been committed to the said jail for having violated any of the Laws of this State, and provided also that the said David Handley do first pay and discharge all costs of said Commitment.
