Whereas a certain John McFarland has been presented by the Grand Jury of
Adams County in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for committing the
crime of fornication, an authenticated copy of which presentment has been
transmitted to me by the Governor of the said Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
and whereas it has been represented to me by His Excellency, William Findlay
Governor of the said Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that the said John
McFarland hath fled from the said Commonwealth from justice into the
