Additional Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County, Lot Lanthicum, vice Lancelot Lanthicum, Capt John Merriken Henry E Mayer, Francis Hancock, Stephen Doon, Richard H Bates William Weems and Richard H Watkins, Commission including them and leaving out Horatio Ridout and James ... who resigned.

John Merriken a Justice of the Levy Court for Anne Arundel vice Henry Duval appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court.

Thomas Emory a Justice of the Orphans Court for Queen Annes County.
