### A Proclamation

Whereas it has been represented to the Executive by William Bruce, esquire, Sheriff of  
Charles County, that John Vincent Looksey, who was sentenced by Charles County Court,  
at November term last, to suffer death, for committing murder on the body of Washington P.  
Robinson, made his escape from the Jail of the said County on the second Instant; and that  
it is believed that he could not have effected the same, had it not have been for the aid of  
accomplices. Now therefore, I Samuel Sprigg, Governor of the State of Maryland, have thought  
it proper to issue this my Proclamation, hereby requiring and exhorting all civil officers  
and other good citizens of the State of Maryland, to use every exertion in their power, to  
arrest and secure the said John Vincent Looksey; and I do, further, by and with the advice  
and consent of the Council, offer a reward of two hundred dollars to any person or persons
