

within the State or elsewhere, who shall apprehend the said John Vincent Corksey, and deliver him over to the custody of the Sheriff of Charles County, and I do further; by and with the advice and consent of the said Council, offer a reward of two hundred dollars to any person who shall discover and make known the name or names of the person or persons who may have aided the said John Vincent Corksey in making his escape, provided he or they be brought to justice. Given in Council, at the City of Annapolis, under the great seal of the State of Maryland, this twenty fourth day of January, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and twenty one.
