The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honourable John Heydon,
James Butcher and Grafton Duvall.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jehu Chandler, sixty five doll-
ars and twenty five cents for Stationary for the use of the Executive and so forth, as per account papered.
