By the Petition of Samuel B. Cooper accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of Baltimore City Court, it appears that he was fined by the said Court at November Term last in four cases the sum of twenty four Dollars in each case for selling spirituous liquors without license. The Petitioner states that for several years past he obtained from the City Court a license and permission to keep a House of entertainment, and to retail spirituous liquors - that at the time when his licence last expired, he suffered a few days to elapse before he applied for a renewal thereof, and did in the interval continue to retail his liquors as usual, without referring to the date of his license or knowing that the time limited therein had ended. The Petitioner states that he is poor and unable to pay the said forfeitures. The Board do on the recommendation of the said City Court order and direct that the said Samuel B. Cooper be released from the said four fines, on the said Cooper's paying thirty dollars, the price of a licence.
