Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nimian Pinkney, three hundred and seventy five dollars, for one Quarters Salary as Clerk of the Council, due the first Instant.

By the Petition of Jackson Hammond, accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of Anne Arundel County Court, it appears, that he was fined by Anne Arundel County Court, at April term eighteen hundred and seventeen, the sum of five dollars, for an assault and Battery committed on the person of William Purnier. The Petitioner states that in consequence of insult and abuse from the said Purnier, he chastised him with a cane that he has paid the fees arising on said prosecution but is now in the custody of the Sheriff for the fine which he is wholly unable to pay - and it being stated to the Executive by several respectable characters, who are acquainted with the said Hammond and the said Purnier, that the said Purnier is worthless and merited the chastisement he received. The Board do remit the said fine.
