Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonas Green Esquire seven hundred and five dollars and sixty nine cents, it being the balance of his account for printing the laws lately compiled by Chancellor Selby and others, after deducting six thousand dollars that had been previously advanced to him on account.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Brewer, Esquire seventy five dollars for one quarters Salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates, due the first of February last.

Ordered, that the Register of Wills for Anne Arundel County be authorized to employ some person to make a new pair of steps leading to his office.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to General Pere Benson, sixty dollars, for one Quarters half pay due the first of February last, under the provisions of the Act of Assembly passed at November Session seventeen hundred and eighty five. Entitled "An Act for the relief of certain maimed and disabled Officers."

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jacob Metzger, Junin, one hundred and fifty dollars for one half years Salary as Armourer at Frederick Town, due the 26<sup>th</sup> of November last.
