It appearing by a certificate of the Orphans Court of Somerset County, that a debt on Judgment due to the State of Maryland, from William S. Hamdy late Sheriff of Somerset County, and William Waller Senior, Richard Waller, Beltha Christopher, Josiah Broughton, Samuel Heath and John Miles Securities, for six hundred and eighty one dollars and seventy five Cents, with interest from the first of November eighteen hundred and sixteen till paid, and costs is well and sufficiently secured. The Governor and Council do on the application of the said parties order and direct, that all proceedings on the said Judgment be stayed until the first day of January eighteen hundred and twenty two provided a receipt is produced to the District Attorney of the fourth Judicial District, or to the Sheriff of Somerset County, on or before the thirtieth Instant, signed by the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore showing that all the Interest due on the said debt and all the cost have been duly paid and satisfied.
