

Ordered, that The Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Brewer, Esquire, Register of the Land Office for the Western Shore one hundred and nineteen dollars, for Books and stationery furnished to make General Index of Land titles.

Ordered, that John Brewer Esquire, Register of the Land Office for the Western Shore be allowed, independent of stationery, one Thousand dollars, for making an Index to Debt Books. Thereupon an Order issued in his favour on the Treasurer of the Western Shore for five hundred dollars, it being the balance due him after deducting the five hundred dollars that had been advanced to him on account. see Resolution Decemberth eighteen hundred and eighteen.
