The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honourable

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Aquila Barnett, one hundred and twenty three dollars and fifty cents, for bringing George. W. Bewley a fugitive from justice from the State of Pennsylvania, as per account papered and filed.

Ordered, that The Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Andrews Slicer, seventy one Dollars, for making venetian shutters to chancery office, and repairing staircase as per account papered and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Munroe, sixty six dollars and forty nine cents, for Postages for the Executive, as per account papered & filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Ichu Chandler, fifty seven dollars, for publishing sundry laws altering the Constitution &c. and for Paper furnished the Executive, as per account papered and filed.

Ordered, that The Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Robt, one hundred and two dollars and fifty cents, for bringing Rezin Wootten a fugitive from justice from Fredericksburgh to Baltimore &c. as per account papered and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Shaw seventy one dollar and twenty five cents, for Binding debt Books for Land Office &c. as per account papered and filed.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor William Ellis Coale, Esq. Benjamin H. Cummins and Henry R. Champayne were appointed Justices of the Peace for Baltimore.
