The State of Maryland, to the Sheriff of Baltimore County Greeting. Whereas a certain John Myers, has been charged by the Affidavit of John Lecher of stealing two Black Horses, and one black Mare the property of John Suchtz alias John Zook of the County of Lancaster in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, which Affidavit has been transmitted to me by the Governor of the said Commonwealth of Pennsylvania— and whereas it has been represented to me by His Excellency Joseph Hester Governor of the said Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that the said John Myers hath fled from the said Commonwealth from justice into the State of Maryland and is now confined in the Jail of Baltimore County. The said Joseph Hester hath in pursuance of the Constitution of the United States and the Act of Congress "entitled" "An Act respecting fugitives from justice and persons escaping from the service of their Masters" demanded of me the said John Myers as a fugitive from justice, and that
