Lean and Smith Mills to be removed to the said Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for trial - provided that the said Daniel Brewer and Robert Tillison have not been committed to the said Jail for having violated any of the laws of this State provided also that the said John M. Lean and Smith Mills do first pay and discharge all costs of the said commitment. Given under my hand, and the Seal of the State of Maryland, this fourteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and twenty one.

Monday September 17th 1821

The Council met. Present His Excellency The Governor and the honourable John Stephen, Thomas H. Wilkinson, James Butcher, James Nabb and Grafton Durrall.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor Garrellson Matthews was appointed Coroner for Caroline County vice William Mulletkin removed to Talbot, and Commission issued to him accordingly.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor Bedy Tubman Bednwalk
