The Petitioner states that the said Courtney Ratcliff did attend according to the time of his Recognizances but through ignorance did not present himself before the Court. That the said Ratcliff soon afterwards died leaving little property of any kind by which the amount of the said Recognizances can be obtained by the State. That the said John Jamison and George Bateman are now under execution for the amount of the several forfeitures which should they be obliged to pay will subject them to great inconvenience. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said forfeitures.
