

until the first day of January eighteen hundred and twenty two - provided a receipt is produced to the District Attorney of the second Judicial District or to the Sheriff of Queen Annes County on or before the day of the meeting of the Court of the said County signed by the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore showing that all the Interest on the said debt and all the Costs have been duly paid and satisfied.

It appearing by a Certificate of the Orphans Court of Queen Annes County, that a debt on Judgment due to the State of Maryland, from Henry Darden security of William Chambers for two thousand one hundred and twenty six dollars and sixty nine Cents is well and sufficiently secured. The Governor and Council do on the application of the said Henry Darden order and direct that all proceedings on the said Judgment be stayed until the first day of January eighteen hundred and twenty two - provided a receipt is produced to the District Attorney of the second Judicial District or to the Sheriff of Queen Annes County on or before the day of the meeting of the Court of the said County, signed by the Treasurer of the Eastern Shore, showing that all the Interest on the said debt and all the Costs have been duly paid and satisfied.
