Thursday October 11th 1891

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable John Stephen, James Butcher and James Kabb.

The Honourable the Chancellor having departed this life on the 10th Instant and it being required, by the Constitution that all Commissions and Grants should be signed by the Chancellor and the Great Seal affixed to them. The Executive postponed acting on the returns of the Election of Sheriffs that had been received and set apart Monday next for the purpose of supplying the vacancy occasioned by the death of the Honourable William Killy. The Honourable Thomas H. Wilkinson and Grafton Durrall were both duly notified of the same by Express and requested to attend.

Friday October 12th 1891
