Register of the Land office for the Eastern Shore, fifty dollars for repairs done to his  
office, as per account papered and filed.

By the Petition of John H. Bayard of Allegany County, accompanied  
by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County, it appears that  
he entered into a Recognizance in the sum of one hundred dollars for the appearance  
of negro Tom, slave of the said John H. Bayard, at Allegany County Court, at October  
Term eighteen hundred and twenty, to testify against negro Bill, another slave of the  
said Bayard, to answer a charge of stealing a hat the property of Jaddock Clark -  
The Petitioner states that the said Negro Bill, has made his escape from the jail of  
Allegany County, and together with the said negro Tom, has left the State and gone  
to Pennsylvania - The Petitioner states that he has made every exertion to procure  
the arrestation of said Bill and Tom, but without success - That the said Negro  
was declared to be forfeited at November Term eighteen hundred and twenty.
