The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable Israel D. Maulsby, Thomas H. Wilkinson, Nicholas Barber and James Nath.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George McCulloch, Michael C. Sprigg and Thomas Blair Esquires, appointed by virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly passed at December Session eighteen hundred and eighteen Commissioners to inspect the United States Turnpike Road running through Allegany County, the sum of seventy five dollars as a compensation for their services.

Ordered, that the Announcer at Frederick Town deliver to Captain Lewis Fletcher sixty uncleaned Muskets and the like number of Cartouch Boxes for the use of Uniform Company commanded by him, provided the said Lewis Fletcher do pay the expense of packing up and delivering said arms, as also the expense of bringing the same.
