ing up and delivering said arms - as also the expense of transportation.

Ordered, that the Armourer at Easton deliver to Captain Alexander B.
Hanson, fifty uncleaned Muskets and the like number of Cartouch Boxes for the use
of the Company commanded by him, provided the said Alexander B. Hanson do first
pay the expense of packing up and delivering the said arms, as also the expense of
transportation.

Ordered, that the Armourer at Annapolis, deliver to Captain Frederick W.
Loring, seventy stand of uncleaned Muskets, with the necessary accoutrements, for the
use of the Uniform Company commanded by him, provided the said Frederick W.
Loring do first pay the expense of packing up and delivering said arms, as also the expen-
se of transportation.

Ordered, that the Armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Samuel
Cople, seventy five stands of uncleaned Muskets, and the like number of Car-
touche Boxes, for the use of the Uniform Company commanded by him, provided
Samuel Cople do first pay the expense of packing up and delivering said arms
the expense of transportation.
