

Wednesday February 20th 1822.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable Israel D. Mausby, Thomas H. Wilkinson, Nicholas Brewer and James Nabb.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Washington G. Tuck the sum of three hundred and twenty five dollars and sixty six Cents the amount of an account for a Book case for the Council Room, packing up and delivering Arms and so forth; and the balance of a former account for removing Arms from Baltimore to Annapolis and Frederick Town; as per account paper and filed.

Henry Thompson was appointed to distribute the laws and votes and proceedings on the Western Shore, and Lambert Gleyland to distribute the laws and votes and proceedings on the Eastern Shore.
