

Ordered, that the Clerk of this Department request the Attorney General of this State, to prosecute either in the County Court of Harford or Cecil Counties, any person or persons who have been or may be charged with unlawfully obstructing the navigation of the River Susquehanna by a Springdam, or erecting or making any nuisance on the same in any part of the said River, which is the dividing line between the said Counties, and the said Attorney General is authorized to employ counsel to assist him in any prosecutions that have been, or may be instituted on account of the same in either of the said Counties, if he shall deem it necessary.
