

The State of Maryland, to the Sheriff of Baltimore County, greeting.

Whereas it appears by an Indictment found in the City and County of New York that a certain Joseph Anthony, is charged with a Larceny and Robbery

perpetrated in the said City and County of New York, an authenticated copy

of which Indictment has been transmitted to me by His Excellency DeWitt

Clinton, Governor of the State of New York, and the said DeWitt Clinton

having stated to me, that the said Joseph Anthony has fled from the said State

from justice, into the State of Maryland, and has in pursuance of the Constitu-

tion of the United States required that I would cause the said Joseph

Anthony to be arrested and secured, so that he may be delivered to Mr Jacob

Harap whom he has appointed Agent to receive him and to remove him into

the said State of New York, to answer the crime of which he is charged - you

are hereby ordered and directed to arrest the said Joseph Anthony if he shall

be found within the limits of Baltimore County and deliver him to the said

Jacob Harap, the Agent appointed to receive him provided the said Joseph

Anthony, is not charged with having violated any of the laws of this state,

and provided also, that the said Jacob Harap do first pay and discharge all

costs of commitment. Given under my hand, and the Great Seal of the State
