it being the balance of his account for Wood purchased for the General Assembly, as per
account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Kennedy, Esq.,
since appointed Agent for the Western Shore, in virtue of the Act of Assembly papered at
the last Session, intitled "an Act authorizing the appointment of an Agent" the sum of
three hundred dollars to be accounted for.

Ordered that the Clerk of the Council forward seals for the use
of the several Tobacco Inspectors in Anne Arundel, Prince Georges, Calvert and Balti-
more Counties - The seals were forwarded to the Clerks of the said Counties, together
with a statement of the cost - to be laid before the Levy Court as the law directs -
