Ordered, that the Bond given by Captain Annan in 1815, for the return of
Stand of Arms, that was loaned to him by the Executive, be cancelled upon Captain
Donaldson giving such Bond to the State as shall be approved of by Colonel Thomas C. W.
ington, or upon the arms being returned to the Armory at Frederick Town in good order,
and upon his receipt for them being transmitted to and received by this Department.

Ordered that Washington G. Tuck be authorized to cause the Platform on the Steeple
of the State House, to be repaired and that he be further requested to cause the roof of the
same to be carefully examined and all leaks therein stopped, and the Roof including the
remainder of the Steeple to be painted.

Ordered, that the Act to alter and repeal such parts of the Constitution and form
of Government of this State, as relate to the division of Frederick County into Election Dis-
tricts, be published in the Maryland Republican and all the Papers in Frederick Town.

Ordered, that the Act to repeal all that part of the Constitution and Form of
Government as relates to the division of Dorchester County into five separate Election Dis-
tricts, be published once a week, for six weeks, in the Maryland Republican, the Eastern Star and
Paston Gazette.

Ordered, that Washington G. Tuck be requested to cause the three brass Cannon
to be repaired.

Ordered, that Thomas Kennedy, Agent for the Western Shore be furnished with a
copy of the Laws of Maryland complete, furnished accordingly with Hinge laws and the
