The Petitioner states, and the same is confirmed by the oath of the said Lanham, that a reconciliation took place between Hallow M Jones and Lanham, and that the Magistrate who had taken the Recognizance, informed the said Lanham, that he should not make a return of the Recognizance to the Court, and that it was unnecessary for him to attend Court, as there would be nothing against him, which was the reason of his not appearing agreeably to the terms of the Recognizance. The Board do on consideration of which circumstances, and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County, release the said Peter D. Hallow and William H. White, from the said forfeiture.
