Use the recommendation of His Excellency the Governor, William H. Hoar, James Boyle, Ciguier and Colonel Ezekiel T. Chambers, were appointed Commissioners to meet such Commissioners as may be appointed for the same purpose by the Commonwealth of Virginia, to settle and adjust in conjunction with them by mutual compact between the two Governments, the Western limits of the State of Maryland, and the dividing line and boundary between the said State and the Commonwealth of Virginia, to commence at the most western head of the North branch of the Potomac River, and to run a due North course to intersect the line between this State, and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and also to settle and adjust any claim of this State, or of the Commonwealth of Virginia to Territory within the limits of the other.

By the Petition of John Barber of Anne Arundel County, accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County, it appears that he was fined by the Court of the said County at April Term last, twenty dollars for an assault and battery upon a certain Henry Sutter. The Petitioner states that the said assault was committed on him by the said Sutter but of this there was produced no proof before the Court as the only witness examined in the cause was the Prosecutor himself. The Petitioner states that he is about seventeen years of age and that the said Sutter is a man of full age, and of much strength and physical power. The Board do on the recommendation of a number of respectable persons inhabitants of the said County, remit the said fine of twenty dollars.
