Council Chamber Annapolis June 13th 1822

I have laid your letter applying for the loan of fifty swords and fifty Pistols before the Executive, and I am authorized by them to say, that you can have them, provided a Bond for their safe return in good order when required to do so, shall have been first executed and forwarded to this Department. You will understand that they are to be selected from those that are not cleaned and the expense of transportation is to be borne by you. There were one hundred and thirty five Pistols, and one hundred and thirty five swords, loaned to the Officers of the first Regimental Cavalry District, on 1812. Will you be pleased to say what has become of them - none of them have been returned to either of the Generals of the State.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Brewer, seventy five dollars for one Quarters salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates, due the first of May last.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Kelly, thirty seven dollars and fifty cents, for one Quarters salary as Clerk of the Senate, due the 1st of May last.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Wm Levacher, forty dollars for one Quarters half pay due the first of May last, under the provisions of the act of Assembly passed at November Session seven teen hundred and eighty five, Chapter 52.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jehu Chandler, three hundred and fifty dollars, for one Quarters salary as Painter to the State, due the first of May last.
