Ordered that the Treasurer of the Marine Store pay to Jeremiah L. Boyd, two hundred and twenty four dollars and fifty seven and an half cents, the amount of duty and the Marine Store \$112.50 for recruiting and strength and the balance for paper for selling letters \$112.50 as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer at Freetown Town, deliver to Captain Benjamin Langley twenty five third of buns undressed and the like number of backboard Buns for the use of the aforementioned Company commanded by him. The expense of transportation packing and delivery to be paid by him.

By the Petition of James Smith of Town bounded hereby accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the said Court that he was present and found guilty at April term eighteen hundred and twenty two of an assault and battery on the persons of George and Richard Miller and was fined in each case the sum of five dollars by the said Court. The Petitioner states that he unfortunately and for the first time committed an offence against the law, and that his conduct, although in violation of the law produced no injury to the persons, and that no battery attended said assaults. The Petitioner states that he is a poor man with a large and helpless family and that he cannot pay said fines without subjecting them to great injury. That he has always supported a fair character.
