The Petitioner states, and the same is confirmed by the Sheriff and Prosecutor, that he did attend said Court at the said term, and called on Julius Forrest, Esquire, the then acting Prosecutor, who after examining the Packet, informed him, that no such Recognizance appeared against him, and that he might return home, as the Magistrate had made me return - that he left Court, and returned home, under an impression that on more mature consideration, the Magistrate had determined that as he was not the aggressor, and had not violated the laws of the State, that he ought not to be recognized to appear at Court, as a disturber of the peace. The Board do on the recommendation of the Court of the said County, and a number of respectable persons, annul the said forfeited Recognizance.
