The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable
Issac D. Moulby, Nicholas Brewer, and James Nabb.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, E. S. Thomas, was appointed
a Justice of the Peace House for Baltimore County, vice James Martin, who is ap-
pointed Inspector of Fish in the custom house, in Baltimore, and commission
issued to him accordingly.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, Colonel Richard Waters,
was appointed Inspector of Tobacco at Dugan's Warehouse, in Baltimore County, vice
Stephen J. Johns deceased, and commission issued to him accordingly.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, John Coxall, was appointed
an Inspector and border of fire wood brought by water to the City of Baltimore for sale,
for the 1st and 10th Wards, vice John Frazer, deceased, and commission issued accordingly.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, Robert W. Kent was appoin-
ted a Justice of the Levy Court of Anne Arundel County, vice Henry Woodward, de-
ceased, and a new commission issued to Benjen Eslop, John Mercken, Richard G. Stockell,
Jes Lenthicum, John Frame, Christopher L. Gant and Robert W. Kent as Justices of the
Levy Court of Anne Arundel County.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor the following Militia appointments
were made - In the 1st Regiment, in the first Regiment's Cavalry District, John B.
Hall Captain of a Troop of Horse, vice Joveranger resigned, Benjamin Rutherford
