of Proclamation.

It bears in General Assembly of Maryland, did by an Act passed at Annapolis
 the year eighteen hundred and four, entitled, "An Act to reduce unto one the several
 Acts of Assembly respecting elections, and to regulate said elections," direct, that the
 Governor and Council, after having received the returns of the elections of Members
 to represent this State in the Congress of the United States, should examine and
 ascertain the number of votes given for each and every person voted for as Member
 of Congress, respectively, and shall thereupon declare, by Proclamation, signed
 by the Governor, the names of the Person or Persons duly elected in each respect-
 ive district. It is pursuant of the directions of the said Act, do by this said Proclamation
 certify that in the returns made to us it appears that Raphael Heale, Esquire
