

of the common necessities of life - that while labouring under these distresses he was
 advised to supply travellers and others with victuals and drink, and that the profits
 arising therefrom would assist in the support of his helpless family, and on credit he
 obtained some bacon and whiskey, with which he furnished travellers and others who
 called for the same - He expressly avers that at the time of selling he had no knowledge
 that he was offending against the law. The Board do in consideration of which circum-
 stances and the recommendation of the Court of the said County, remit the said fines
 of sixteen dollars each.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the legal representative of John Chandler
 three hundred and fifty dollars for one Quarter's salary as Punkee to the State due the first Instant.

By the Petition of Jacob Wootley, of Baltimore County, accompanied by a Transcript
 from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County, it appears that he was fined in two
 cases by Baltimore City Court, at September Term last, the sum of sixteen dollars in each
 case, for selling spirituous liquors without license - The Petitioner states that he has for
 a number of years regularly taken out license and kept a public house in Baltimore Cou-
 nty - that when the Court set he was ill - that subsequently he sent down for a license, but
 could not obtain one in consequence of the absence of the Judges, who were holding Court
 in Harford County - that he sold notwithstanding, being unaware that it was illegal to do
 so, and intending to renew his license. The Board do in consideration of which circumstances
 and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County, remit the said fines of 16th each.
