By the Petition of Aaron Crawford of Frederick County it appears that he was fined by Frederick County Court at October Term eighteen hundred and twenty two, two dollars and sentenced to confinement in Frederick County Goal until the tenth day of January eighteen hundred and twenty three for an assault. The Petitioner states that his family consisting of a wife and seven children are in an exceedingly deplorable situation, and require for their support his daily labour. The Petitioner states that he is totally unable to pay the said fine. The Board do on the recommendation of the Honourable Abraham Shawee an associate Judge of the said Court remit the said fine of two dollars.
