Saturday January the 6th 1823

Ordered that The Treasurer of The Western Shore pay to Mr Caleb Daves one hundred and eight dollars for his allowance and expences for bringing Jedulum M^l Daniel from the State of Delaware and John Giblets from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fugitives from the justice of this State, as per account papered and filed.
