Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Thompson thirty eight dollars and ninety three and three quarters cents for riding papers to General Smith with his credentials, to the Sheriff of Baltimore with a writ of Election, and to Joseph Wickes Clerk of Kent County Court as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Thompson sixty dollars for making fines in the Court of Appeals and Auditors office and cleaning the same as per account papered and filed.
