

From Wednesday February the 5th to Tuesday February 18th 1823 inclusive His Excellency the Governor and the honourable Nicholas Brewer appeared in the Council Chamber.

Wednesday February the 19th 1823

His Excellency the Governor and the honourable Israel D. Maulby and Nicholas Brewer appeared in the Council Chamber.

Ordered that Captain Benjamin Brooks of Calvert County, and his securities Francis S. Donnell and Daniel Kent Esquires return to the Armory at Annapolis sixty three Rifles with the accoutrements, that were loaned by the Executive on the 14th of June 1820 for the use of the Rifle Company commanded by the said Brooks.

Thursday February 20th 1823

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor, and the honourable Philemon Chew, Israel D. Maulby and Nicholas Brewer.

The Board that was given by Captain Page and others of Kent County for the return of seventy two Muskets and seventy two Cartouch Boxes loaned on the nineteenth day of March eighteen hundred and thirteen for the use of the Company commanded by him was delivered up and cancelled it being certified by James Hedges Esquire who acted as Agent for Mr. Jump in the same County that the said Arms and accoutrements were delivered to him by the said Page and sent to the Armory at Eastern.

Ordered that the Armours at Annapolis deliver to Captain Job G. Stansbury of Baltimore County forty uncleaned swords and forty uncleaned Pistols. The expense of transportation to be paid by said Stansbury.

Ordered that the Armours at Annapolis deliver to Captain David R. Gist twenty uncleaned swords and twenty uncleaned Pistols. The expense of transportation to be paid by the said David R. Gist of Baltimore County.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor James H. A. Middleton was appointed a Justice of the Peace for Charles County and a new Commission issued to Francis
