

Ordered that the Arrows at Annapolis deliver to Captain Frederick Wilson 30 uncleaned swords and thirty uncleaned Pistols for the use of the Troop of Horse commanded by him. The expense of Transportation to be paid by said Wilson.

Ordered, that Jeremiah Hughes Esquire, be employed to print the Laws and Votes and Proceedings of the General Assembly passed at the present Session, agreeably to the provisions of the Act of Seventeen hundred and ninety, Chapter 51, Section 3 and in conformity to the sixty fourth Resolution passed at November Session eighteen hundred and eleven, and that he enter into Bond to the State of Maryland in the penalty of twenty eight hundred Dollars with security conditioned for the faithful performance of the same. Allowed 1400 to be paid on the completion of the said work.

Ordered, that the 1st, 2^d, 3^d, 5th and 6th Sections of the Act "Entitled, "An Act laying duties on licenses to retailers of dry goods and for other purposes," passed at December Session eighteen hundred and nineteen, Chapter 134, and the 1st, 2^d and 3^d Sections of an Act, Entitled, "A Supplement to the Act laying duties on licenses to retailers of dry goods, and for other purposes" passed at December Session eighteen hundred and twenty one, be published twice a week, in each week, for six weeks, in the Maryland Republican and Maryland Gazette at Annapolis; The Patriot, American and Federal Gazette at Baltimore; The Political Examiner at Frederick Town; Groves and Herberts Paper at Hagers Town; The Star at Easton and the National Intelligencer.
