

Wednesday May 7th 1823

The Council met Present. His Excellency The Governor. The Honorable Thomas Emory, Joshua Pideaux, Philimon Chew, Nicholas Brewer and Isaac D Maulby

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor the following Militia Appointments were made-

For the 24 Regiment Washington County-

William D Beatt Captain vice Quintrill resigned, George F Keys Lieut vice Murray resigned and Otho H. W. Bell Ensign vice Bell promoted.

For the First Regiment in the First Regimental Cavalry District

Horatio Watkins Second Lieutenant of Captain John R Dalls Troop of Horse vice Tilghman resigned, Andrew Rantch Cornet of said Troop of Horse vice Holman resigned.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor Amos Loney was appointed an additional Justice of the Peace for Baltimore County.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor Thomas Kennedy was appointed Agent for the collection of Debts due from citizens residing on the Western Shore vice Thomas Kennedy resigned on the 3^d of December 1822

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor Theodorick Wland, George Winchester and John Patterson, were appointed Commissioners to fix on a route for a canal which will connect the waters of the Susquehanna and the City of Baltimore.

The Honorable Isaac D Maulby moved that two of the three Commissioners required to be appointed to examine the practicability and select a route for a canal from the Potomac river to the City of Baltimore be taken from
