Stay of Executions, printing of States letters about slaves, Notice about Kilty's Statute  
Law relating to Inspection of Tobacco, Pension Act - Agents Law, Notice for a Loan,  
Proclamation recommending a day of fast, Notice about direct Tax, Law laying  
duties on retailers. And sundry Proclamations as per account passed & filed -

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Frederick G.  
Shaeffer, three dollars and fifty cents, for publishing Notice to Levy Courts to meet  
about a direct Tax -

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Isaac  
Monroe, fifty three dollars for publishing Laws altering constitution as relates  
to the division of Baltimore County - Resolution appointing a day of prayer - Notice  
to Levy Courts to meet about direct Tax, The act relating to Dry Goods retailers,  
and a Proclamation announcing the names of the persons elected members of  
Congress.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Cole, five dollars  
for publishing the Resolution of the Legislature appointing a day of prayer, & Notice to  
Levy Courts to meet for the purpose of levying direct Tax.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Monroe, fifty  
eighty three dollars and fifty three cents, for Postages for the Executive Department, from  
first of January 1823 to thirty first of March 1823.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Solomon G.
