Departed This life at the City of Annapolis, on the 31 of December, Anno Domini 1822, after a short illness, The Honorable William Craig Jun^r Delegate from Cecil County, in the thirty sixth year of his age - erected by order of the Honorable the House of Delegates, as a Testimonial of their respect for the deceased -

Ordered, the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honorable Theodorick Bland, George Wenchester and John Patterson, Esquires, Commissioners to Survey a Route of a Canal from the Susquehanna River to the City of Baltimore, three thousand dollars, to be accounted for -

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Athanasius Fenwick, William Howard and William Price, Esquires, Commissioners to fix on a Route of a Canal from the Potomac River to the City of Baltimore, or either of them, one thousand doll^s, to be accounted for -

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis, deliver to Doctor William Howard of Baltimore, one of the Potomac Commissioners, two Wall Tents, for the use of the said Commissioners -

Ordered, that the Armourer at Frederick Town, deliver to Captain William C. Keller, seventy five Stand of uncleaned Muskets, & seventy five C^s.
