

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Washington S. Esquire, two hundred and eighty four dollars and forty cents three fourths cent, it being the amount of Mr Boyd and others Bill for work done to the State House, erecting a shed house to put wood in, for the Treasury Department (including materials), making boxes to put Laws on, as per account passed & filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Brown Esquire, Examiner General for the Western Shore, two hundred and forty dollars and eighty four and one third cents, it being the balance of six months salary due him on the fourth Instant, after deducting the amount of fees received by him to the said fourth of June.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Coulter six dollars, for examining situation of Cartouch Boxes, being six days employed in said work.

Ordered, that the Armourer at Easton, send to the Armourer at Annapolis, thirty six Artillery Swords, one six pound Field Piece complete and twenty Pistols.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, Daniel Whitmor was appointed second Lieutenant of Captain Bains Troop of Horse in the first Regiment, in the first Regimental Cavalry District, of the Militia of this State in Washington County. The Honorable Israel D. Maulsby appeared.

The Council met present His Excellency the Governor and the Honorable Thomas Emory and Nicholas Brewer and Israel D. Maulsby.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Washington S. Esq, thirty dollars and seven and one quarter cents, for repairs to Government House, as per account passed and filed.
