Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Thompson, fourteen dollars and forty three and three quarters cents for Stationery furnished for the use of the Executive - and for drayage paid for acts of Congress - as per account passed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Washington G. Tuck, one hundred and thirty one dollars and thirty cents, the amount of Sundry Bills for removing the Powder from the Magazine at Fort Severn to the County - for a lock for the Senate Chamber, repairing the State House Window sills, as per account and vouchers passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Munro, eighty seven dollars and sixty one cents, for Postages for the Executive Department, as per account passed & filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Kevin Burgoin, the sum of fifty dollars, it being the amount the amount of a Reward that was offered by Governor Sprigg on the 24th of April 1822 for the apprehension of William Shields charged with Horse Stealing, the said K Burgoin having produced the receipt of the Sheriff of Cecil County for the said Shields -

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Willingham, one hundred dollars, it being the Reward offered by Governor Lloyd, on the 30th day of July 1811, for John Badger who made his escape from the public Roads of Baltimore County, to which punishment he had been
