Ordered, that the armourer at Frederick Town, deliver to Captain William H Poole of Frederick County, seventy five stand of Uncleaned Muskets, seventy five Cartouch Boxes for the use of the company commanded by him, the expense of transportation to be borne by Poole,

Ordered, that the armourer at Frederick Town, deliver to Captain Charles Devilliss, seventy five uncleaned Muskets, seventy five Cartouch Boxes for the use of the company commanded by him, the expense of transportation to be borne by said Devilliss.

Ordered, that Major William Stansbury of Baltimore, deliver to Captain William Willis, of Frederick County, seventy five Rifles, for the use of the Uniform Rifle Company commanded by him, to be taken from the \$100 loaned to said Stansbury in April 1822 -

Ordered, that Major William Stansbury, deliver to Captain George Whist, seventy five Rifles and Cartouch Boxes, out of those received from the General Government, in April 1822 for the use of the Uniform Rifle Company commanded by him.

By the Petition of John Rantler and Horatio C. Scott of Prince Georges County it appears, that they entered into a Recognizance in the sum of 1000 dollars each for the appearance of a certain William James a free man of colour, at Prince Georges
