

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Col Richard Anderson, one hundred and twenty dollars for six months half pay due the first Instant; under the provisions of an Act of Assembly passed in 1785.

Ordered, that the armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Joshua C. List, fifty swords, twenty uncleaned Pistols and fifty Holsters - the expense of transportation to be borne by said List.

Ordered, that the armourer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Richard G. Hutton, sixty Pickers and Baushes, twelve Gun Screws and twelve Screw Drivers for the use of the company commanded by him.

Ordered That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Theodorick Bland, George Winchester and John Patterson, Esquires, Commissioners to Survey a Route of Canal from the Susquehanna River to the City of Baltimore fifteen hundred dollars to be accounted for.

Ordered, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Athanasius Fennick, William Howard, and William Price, Esquires Commissioners to fix on a Route of a Canal from the Potomac to the City of Baltimore one thousand dollars to be accounted for.
