Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gacoves and Herbert, fifty nine dollars and twelve and a half cents, for publishing a Resolution appointing a day of humiliation and prayer, act laying duties on retailers licenses, to provide a revenue, act respecting civil rights, Proclamations for the apprehension of Duwall and Smings and an order recognizing J. J. Hoogewuth as Consul of the Netherlands, as per account papered and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mrs Ann Levacher forty dollars for one Quarters pension due the first of November last.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Thompson one hundred dollars to purchase wood for the General Assembly, to be accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Miriam Pondeney ~~forty~~ ^{twenty five} dollars, for expenses incurred in going to the Eastern Shore in the case of Lowe against the State and for sundry copies furnished the Attorney General.
