Saturday January 10th 1824

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor, and the
honorable Thomas Emory, Philomen Chew, Robert M. Archer and Nichol. Brewer

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Thomp-
son, thirty three dollars for riding expers to our Senators and Representatives
in Congress at Washington, with Resolutions of the General Assembly of Maryland,
respecting congressional caucuses, and for going expers to the Sheriff of Queen Annes
county, with a writ of commutation for Dick Gould, under sentence of death, as per
account paper and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Thompson,
sixty dollars for making fees in the Quaitors and Court of Appeals &c.
