The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable Thomas Conroy, Joshua Prudeaux, Philemon Chew, Robert H. Archer and Nicholas Baer.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr. Gerber West, twenty seven dollars, it being the amount of his account for services performed in eighteen hundred and twenty two, by order of the Potomac Commissioners in surveying by their direction in said year, and for going to the mouth of Goose Creek, by order of Colonel Williams, one of said Commissioners, as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Marmaduke W. Boyd, one hundred and ninety three dollars, it being the balance of his account for services performed in eighteen hundred and twenty two, by order of the Potomac Commissioners, in surveying and levelling, and attending the said Commissioners at different times, after deducting one hundred and fifteen dollars that were advanced to him, by Messieurs Mason, Taylor and Fenwick (Commissioners), as per account passed and filed.

Ordered, that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Isaac Bugg, one thousand dollars, in part of his account as Engineer to the Potomac Commissioners, to be accounted for.
