

Tuesday January the 30<sup>th</sup> 1824

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable Thomas Emory, Joshua Redman, Chilesman Chew, Robert H. Archer and Nicholas Brown.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor Joseph Hook was appointed Captain of a Company in the 5<sup>th</sup> Regiment of the Militia of the State in Baltimore City vice Tinson resigned.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor Lewis Eichalberg, John S. Shriver, and Richard M. Allen were appointed Insolvent Commissioners for the City and County of Baltimore and commission issued accordingly.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor David Baker was appointed Inspector of Ground Oak Bark intended for exportation from the City of Baltimore and commission issued accordingly.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor James L. Hawkins, Nathaniel F. Williams and James B. Ringgold were appointed Lottery Commissioners and commission issued accordingly.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor Joseph Messinger, John Hele, and Jacob Councilman were appointed Trustees of the Com for the City and County of Baltimore and commission issued accordingly.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor the following persons were appointed Inspectors of Lumber for the City and County of Baltimore to wit. George Hall, Joshua Swann, James C. King, Nicholas Burke, John Ready, Henry Messing, Jacob Manchester, John H. Thompson, Christian Clemons and John Norton and commission issued accordingly.
