Ordered that the Arsenal at Annapolis deliver to Captain Hugh Ely, forty nine new Rifles, that were forwarded by Major Stensbury to him in August last, with the necessary accoutrements for the use of the Rifle company commanded by him. The expense of transportation to be borne by said Ely.

Ordered that Colonel William Stensbury deliver to Captain Hugh Ely, the twenty six Rifles remaining in his hand of the four hundred that he received from the General Government in May 1822 with the necessary accoutrements for the use of the Rifle Company commanded by said Ely. The expense of transportation to be borne by the said Ely.

Ordered that the Arsenal at Annapolis deliver to Captain Lewis Nett, seventy five Powder Horns, and seventy five Pouches for the use of the Rifle Company by him.
